On 27<sup>th</sup> February 2024, Academician Hristo Beloev, Rector for the period 2007–2016 and 2018–2023 was awarded the title Honorary Rector of the University of Ruse with a Decision of the Academic Council. This honorary title recognizes Academician Beloev's outstanding contribution for

Academician Hristo Beloev is the longest-serving rector in the history of the University of Ruse with exceptional merits in the field of management and improvement of the university facilities. He has also contributed immensely to the popularity of the University of Ruse in Bulgaria and abroad by working hard for the implementation of its mission, strategic

goals and objectives.

An initiating committee has submitted a proposal to the Academic Council of the University of Ruse to award Academician Hristo Beloev the title of Honorary Rector of the University of Ruse.

This act comes as evidence of the respect the

academic community of the University of Ruse bestows to Academician Hristo Beloev as a scientist, lecturer, public figure and a person. This respect is justified by his scientific and creative achievements, which have gained national and international fame, determined by the citation index, as well as by the prestigious awards received by him.

In his turn, Academician Beloev expressed his cordial gratitude:

"I have received many awards, but this act has really moved me deeply. I accept it as a strong sign of respect and appreciation. When I first came and became an assistant professor after graduating the University, I had never imagined that I could become its rector. Through the years, I was developing my potential step by step until I earned the right to be elected to this position. # Assoc. Prof. Desislava Atanasova is the new Rector of the University of Ruse

First Honorary Rector

On 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2025 the Assembly General of the University of Ruse conducted a procedure for partial elections and elected its Rector for the mandate 2024–2027. Assoc. Prof. Desislava Atanasova, PhDEng, received majority vote of trust and is the new Rector of the University of Ruse.

In her address to the Assembly General, Assoc. Prof. Atanasova declared that she will do her best to ensure that the University of Ruse is modern, innovative and prosperous. She vowed to govern the prestigious institution with the same dedication as that of the previous rectors. Assoc. Prof. Atanasova emphasized the fact that the University of Ruse is a valuable and desired institutional partner. "Our mission remains unchanged – to provide knowledge, to inspire and enrich the students and PhD students,

preparing them for the challenges with quality, innovations and sustainable academic environment", added Assoc. Prof. Atanasova.

Academician Hristo Beloev – Honorary rector and Chairperson of the Assembly General, congratulated Assoc. Prof. Atanasova and wished her health and success. She was cordially greeted by the immediate past rector Prof. Gencho Popov, PhDEng.

"Thank you for your trust! I hope that it means we are going to work together with dedication and vision in such a way that will ensure the leading position of the University of Ruse in Bulgaria and strengthen its positions in the international space", said Assoc. Prof. Atanasova after the vote was announced.

The official inauguration of Assoc. Prof. Desislava Atanasova, PhDEng, will be held after signing the Governance Contract between the Minister of Education and Science and the elected Rector for the mandate 2024–2027.

#### Scientific Conference of the University of Ruse, 2024

The University of Ruse and the Union of Scientists, Ruse Branch organised the  $63^{\rm rd}$  Annual International Research Conference with scientific and plenary session in three locations, respectively: in Silistra on  $18^{\rm th}$  October, in Ruse on  $25^{\rm th}$ – $26^{\rm th}$  October and in Razgrad on  $8^{\rm th}$ – $9^{\rm th}$  November 2024. Traditionally, there were 30 thematic fields covered in the three cities, where the forum was held.

In his address to the participants and guests of the conference, the rector, Prof. Gencho Popov noted that the University of Ruse has always been a place where knowledge and innovative ideas meet and develop while in times of dynamic changes and global challenges, science and innovations play a key role in the creation of a better future. Expressing his gratitude to the Union of Sciences and the plenary speakers, he emphasized the fact that the International Scientific Conference of the University of Ruse is not only a compilation of research papers and

discussions, but also a place for cooperation, generating new partnerships and ideas.

The following plenary speakers presented their papers at the opening of the Conference:

- Yordanka Chobanova, Head of the European Commission Representation in Bulgaria, on the topic of "The European Commission's Strategic Agenda 2024–2029 Research, Innovation and Education". The paper emphasized on the Commission's plans for future funding of research, focused on strategic priorities, advanced fundamental research and breakthrough innovations. Yordanka Chobanova has been the Head of the European Commission Representation in Bulgaria since March, 2024 and functions as the official representative of the Commission in our country, reporting to the Chairperson Ursula von der Leyen.
- **Prof. Antonios Gasteratos**, Dean of the Engineering Faculty and the Director of the Robotics and Automation Laboratory at Democritus University of





Thrace, Greece, on the topic of "Unmanned Aerial Vehicles: Applications with Embedded Visualization Systems". The author

comments on the growing role of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV) in various areas of application, emphasizing their transformative influence on the industries. Antonios Gasteratos is a professor in robotics, mechatronics and computer vision at Democritus University of Thrace. He is a topic editor-in-chief of Electronics Letters and associate editor of Expert Systems with Applications, International Journal of Optomechatronics, International Journal of Advanced Robotics Systems.

- Kristina Eskenazi, Chairperson of Health&Life Sciences Cluster, Sofia, Bulgaria, on the topic of "(im)Possible AI: Support of spinoff companies". In her paper, she offers an interesting approach to contemporary challenges and opportunities in the field of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and innovations and comments on the ethical aspects of AI, the environmental responsibility of technological innovation and the importance of innovation ecosystems for the success of emerging technologies. Kristina Eskenazi is a member of the Board of Directors of Artificial Intelligence Cluster, Bulgaria and the Confederation of Employers and Industrialists in Bulgaria. She is also the founder of the International Association for Women's Entrepreneurship in Biotechnology "Global Digital Technologies in Health".

Technologies of Siemens Bulgaria, on the topic of "The Industrial MetaUniverse:

Opportunities and Challenges". The paper presented the opportunities and challenges of the industrial MetaUniverse in the context of a concept for a comprehensive digital world.

The conference participants discussed their views in the following research





fields and topics, in compliance with the Conference topic: Agricultural Machinery and Technologies; Repair and Reliability; Heating, Hydraulic and Pneumatic Engineering; Ecology and Environmental Protection; Industrial Design; Chemical Technologies; Biotechnologies and Food

Technologies; Machine-building and Engineering Technologies; Electrical Engineering, Electronica and Automation; Communication Systems and Networks; Transportation and Mechanical Sciences; Economics and Management; Intercultural and Political Communication; European Studies and International Security; Social work; Mathematics, Informatics and Physics; Pedagogy and Psychology; History, Ethnology and Folklore; Linguistics, Literature and Art History; Health Promotion; Medical and Clinical Diagnostics; Healthcare; Law; National Security; Quality of Higher Education.

The research papers contributed to deeper comprehension, connected to various aspects of regional economic transformation, based on the application of innovative strategies and approaches to the new industries, digital economy, society and its relations with the business environment and the quality of life. Implementing systems thinking is the foundation for creating effective applications and best practices in many areas of science and it influences the development and growth of business. The future is generated in three aspects, which find lasting trends and evidence in the present.

All papers, approved successfully by international double reviewing, are to be published in the respective "Proceedings of the University of Ruse", ser. 63, 2024 and online on the conference website: ISSN 1311-3321 (printed); ISSN 2535-1028 (CD-ROM); ISSN 2603-4123 (online). The publication "Proceedings of the University of Ruse" is included in the international database ISSN. The electronic edition of "Proceedings of the University of Ruse" has been registered in the online research resources portal ROAD with open access and in NACID.

Chairpersons of the conference are Prof Gencho Popov, PhD – Rector of the University of Ruse and Academician Hristo Beloev, DTSc – Chairperson of the Union of Scientists, Ruse Branch, and an Honorary Rector of the University of Ruse, and the scientific secretary is Assoc. prof. Desislava Atanasova, PhD, Vice-rector Science and Research.

#### Conferences at the University of Ruse, 2024

### International Scientific Conference CompSysTech 2024

On  $14^{\rm th}$  June 2024 the  $25^{\rm th}$  International Scientific Conference CompSysTech'24 was opened at the University of Ruse. The sessions continued on  $15^{\rm th}$  June 2024. Altogether, 42 papers of researchers from 19 countries were presented, namely from Jordan, Canada, Kirgizstan, Türkiye, Finland, Mozambique, Portugal, Georgia, Turkmenistan, Kazakhstan, the Netherlands, Vietnam, Greece, Romania, Albania, Great Britain, Slovakia, Spain and Bulgaria.



The organisers of the conference were the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Bulgaria, The Union of Automation and Informatics "John Atanassov" and the University of Ruse.

The participants were greeted by the rector of the University, Prof. Plamen Kangalov, PhD, who noted the importance of the forum, its popularity and its prestigious level – We are glad that CompSysTech has established its popularity in Bulgaria and abroad. The fact that today we have researchers from 19 countries participating face-to-face and online is an obvious evidence for that. Another proof of the attractiveness and the high level of the conference is the fact that more than 17 years the papers, presented at CompSysTech, are published in the virtual library of the Association in computers – the most authoritative international organisation in the field of computing. Moreover, they are also indexed by Scopus. The profile of the conference Google Scholar is also extremely impressive. The fact that the conference has an impact rank should also be specifically noted".

A congratulatory address was also received from the Chairperson of the Union of Automation and Informatics "John Atanasov" Prof. Kosta Boshnakov, PhDEng. The conference was opened with a musical flute performance by Senior Assistant Professor Petya Stefanova, PhD, who was joined by the robot Sana with her dance.





The plenary session was attended by Assoc. Prof. Candelaria Goya from the University of La Laguna, Spain; Assoc. Prof. Antonio Mendes from the University of Coimbra, Portugal; and Prof. Maya Dimitrova, PhD from the Institute of Robotics – Bulgarian Academy of Sciences.

The prizes and certificates were awarded by the Vice-Rector for International Cooperation, Assoc. Prof. Galina Ivanova, PhD and Prof. Tsvetomir Vassilev, PhD – Chairperson of the Conference Programme Committee.

At the initiative of Academician Petar Kenderov, students who have already made a name for themselves and have boasted certain achievements in the field of computing participate in the conference every year with their reports. Two of the reports by students from the Baba Tonka Mathematical High School were awarded the Best Paper Crystal Prize. The students' supervisor is their Informatics teacher, Susan Feimova.

#### International Scientific Conference EE&AE 2024

In the period 27<sup>th</sup>–29<sup>th</sup> June, 2024 the IX International Scientific Conference on Energy Efficiency and Agrarian Engineering (EE&AE 2024) was held at the University of Ruse, with the participation of over 150 scientists from Bulgaria, Romania, Türkiye, India, Mexico, Russia, Ukraine, the Philippines, Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan and others. The event included an industrial session with meetings between representatives of the students, the academia and the business. Leading companies such as Huawei, Photomate, FOT, MIK-GREEN, PM Electrical, Solar MD and others demonstrated their latest innovations in the field of renewable energy and industry.

The conference was opened by Assoc. prof. Boris Evstatiev, DSc and the guests were greeted by the Vice-rector Prof. Gencho Popov, PhDEng.

In his welcoming address, Prof. Popov shared the following – "in the vision of the University of Ruse, spreading knowledge, organizing and carrying out fundamental and applied research, as well as implementing innovations in agriculture, industry and transport occupy leading positions. The impressive number of papers, the encouragement of young researchers, students and PhD students to participate in this scientific event is part of the united efforts for achieving this goal. I am convinced that during the conference you will discuss ideas for joint research, preparation of proposals for participation in various European scientific programmes, which will stimulate young people's interest in engineering sciences. The week started with the International Student Competition Electroniade 2024, with the participation of the student Branches of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE), as well as professional student Branches of Electronics Packaging Society (EPS) from Bulgaria and Romania. In this competition, the young people demonstrated their knowledge and skills in the field of electronics and the best ones were awarded prizes.









On  $26^{th}$  June the First Balkan Meeting of IEEE Student Branches and EPS Professional Branches was opened. During the event, leading lecturers from Photomate (Bulgaria), Microchip Technology (Romania) and Endava (Bulgaria) presented innovative products, solutions and vision for the future in the field of contemporary technologies.



#### **Innovative Events and Projects**

### **European University ACROSS**

In the period 23<sup>rd</sup> –25<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 at the University of Girona, Spain a meeting of the Executive Board of the European University ACROSS – European University for Cross-border Knowledge Sharing. The University of Ruse is full member of the consortium after its successful participation in the last call of the European Commission under the initiative *European Universities* in June 2024.



On behalf of the University of Ruse, the participants in the meeting were Assoc. Prof. Desislava Atanasova, PhD – Vice-rector on Science and Research and Assoc. Prof. Tsvetelina Harakchiyska – Vice-dean of the Faculty of Natural Sciences and Education.

The consortium ACROSS consists of 9 universities, located in European trans-border: The University of Ruse; Technological University Chemnitz, Germany – leader of the consortium; Technical University, Bialystok, Poland; University of Banya Luka, Bosnia and Herzegovina; University of Girona, Spain; University of Craiova, Romania; University Nova Goritsa, Slovenia; University Perpignan, France; University Udine, Italy.

The main purpose of the meeting in Girona was the preparation of the text of the Partnership Agreement, which will be signed by the participating universities in short terms. By the end of September, the agreement between the partners and the European Commission, and the project itself will start on 1st January, 2025 and will continue for four years.

After signing the agreement for funding, the partners will start serious work for the building of a true European University, including common curricula in particular professional fields, common modules in syllabi and intensive student mobility of students and lecturers, as well as developing a common digital platform.

The participation of the University of Ruse in a European University with more than 100 000 students and over 10 000 lecturers and administrative staff will open new perspectives for development of the Ruse Alma Mater. This strengthens the University's position not only as a research university in Bulgaria, but also as an influential centre for education, science and innovation in the European educational and research space.

# The University of Ruse in the Top Ten universities in a World Ranking

The University of Ruse "Angel Kanchev" occupies the prestigious sixth position among the Bulgarian universities according to the latest data, presented in 2024 by the independent institution EduRank, which evaluates universities all over the world using scientometric indicators. The Bulgarian universities included in the world ranking are 47. The Ruse Alma Mater is preceded by Sofia University "St. Kliment Ochridski", Technical University Sofia, Plovdiv University "Paisij Hilendarski", New Bulgarian University and the Medical University – Sofia.

According to EduRank, the most popular publications are those of scientists from the University of Ruse in the fields of engineering, physics, social sciences, computer science, environmental sciences, business and political science. The research profile of the University is made on the basis of 2062 scientific publications with 6082 citations in the international scientometric databases.

The University of Ruse is one of the ten Bulgarian universities with a research status.

# The Ambassador of Ukraine on a Visit to the University of Ruse

On 12<sup>th</sup> November 2024, a ceremony for awarding the honorary title Doctor Honoris Causa of the University of Ruse was held at Kaneff Centre. Academician Volodimir Mihaylovich Bulgakov, DTScEng and Academician Valery Vasiliovich Adamchuk, DTScEng became bearers of the title after the Decision of the Academic Council of the University of Ruse from 22 October, 2024.

Academician Volodimir Mihaylovich Bulgakov, DTScEng is the Head of Department of Mechanics of the National University of Life Sciences, Ukraine. Academician Valery Vasiliovich Adamchuk, DTScEng, is the Director of the Institute of Mechanics and Automation of Agrarian Industrial Manufacturing, Ukraine

In the motivation for conferring the honorary titles to the two Ukrainian scientists provided by the Management of the Agrarian and Industrial Faculty it is read that this is a recognition of their overall contribution to establishing the University of Ruse as a leader in the field of research and design of agricultural machinery in Bulgaria and abroad.

The new honorary Doctors Honoris Causa expressed their gratitude for the honour and gave short academic speeches.



On 16<sup>th</sup> June 2024, a ceremony for awarding the honorary title Doctor Honoris Causa of the University of Ruse to Prof. Jinghui Yang, PhD was held at the University of Ruse. The Decision for conferring the title was made by the Academic Council on 26<sup>th</sup> May, 2024.

In the motivation for conferring the honorary title to the renowned Chinese scientist the Management of the Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Electronics and Automation and the Dean, Assoc. Prof. Vyara Ruseva, PhD, pointed out that this comes as recognition of Prof. Jinghui Yang's contribution to the development and strengthening the cooperation between Shanghai Polytechnical University and the University of Ruse, mostly for the signing and implementation of the Agreement for exchange of students, counselling of PhD students from the Faculty, and participation in the preparation of documentation for acknowledgement of the diplomas, issued by the two universities.





#### **Shell Eco Marathon 2024**

For the eighth year in a row, the student team HydRU Racing Team of the University of Ruse participated in the annual competition Shell Eco Marathon Europe and Africa 2024. The event was held from 19th to 24th May, 2024 on the Paul Armagnac racetrack in Nogaro, France. University and high school teams from Europe and Africa convened to design, build and test their concepts for energy efficient vehicles.

In this year's concept, HydRU Racing Team opted for a complete modification of the car's mechanics with the introduction of a suspension with gas shock absorbers to more effectively dampened vibrations of the supporting system resulting from the action on the road. The car's suspension itself is designed for specific needs and is manufactured on precision CNC machines, which ensure the perfect balance between the highest precision and impeccable surface quality of the parts without the need for additional processing. In terms of increasing the safety of the car, a new braking system was designed, which integrates products from the Wilwood company, a leading manufacturer of braking system components for all types of racing motorsport. For the first time, the team uses a concept for transmitting torque from the electric motor to the chassis using a specially designed gearbox. To increase the efficiency of the



entire system, the team relied on a new generation hydrogen fuel cell from the company Spectronik.

During the tests, it turned out that under high loads, the fuel cell had a problem with the proton exchange membrane, which led to serious degradation of the cell's functions.

The future engineers from the renewed team of the HydRU Racing Team of the University of Ruse (with a single veteran, the main pilot, the student in the degree programme "Technology and Transport Management" Ivan Banchev) demonstrated adaptability and creative thinking and managed to respond to all challenges in an extremely short time, pass the technical inspection and obtain the right to go out on the track and conduct the test and racing sessions.

The team completed all of its test and racing sessions without any technical problems and left the race with many new friendships, gaining experience and emotions, feeling satisfied and motivated to develop the car's capabilities to its maximum limits in order to achieve even greater success in future editions of the race!

### **International Francophonie Day**

Since then, every year the University of Ruse marks the International Francophonie Day with significant initiatives and celebrations. On this day under the hospitable roof of the university, admirers of the French language and culture meet with their creative expressions in literature and art.

The event was attended by the Management of the University. The participants were greeted by the rector, Prof. Plamen Kangalov, PhDEng: "We can proudly claim that the University of Ruse is the initiator and host of the first Conference



of the Francophonie universities in Bulgaria, which are only 9. This year the University will initiate a similar event, dedicated to the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Eastern European headquarters of the Francophonie University Agency, based in Bucharest. They greeted those present with the national anthem of the Republic of France *La Marseillaise*.

A tradition since the first year of the University of Ruse's membership in the Francophonie University Agency, this year's competition for an essay in French had the topic "If only the young knew, if only the old could". The competition also included a presentation in French, a poem, and a translation of a poem from French into Bulgarian. The competition attracted students from Ruse and other cities in the country from schools offering French language studies, as well as students from Bulgaria and abroad.

#### **PhD Research Seminar**

On 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2024, a joint Research Seminar was held for PhD students from Istanbul Cerrahpasa University and the University of Ruse. It was organised by two Faculties – Faculty of Engineering (IUC) and Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Electronics and Automation, respectively.

Good practices in working with doctoral students, topics for joint activities, future Erasmus exchange of students and lecturers from both universities were discussed. Fruitful conversations were held between the doctoral students.





#### **AI Camp 2024**

On 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2024, the International Camp for Artificial Intelligence "AI Camp 2024" was opened. This is the second international camp organised in the framework of the Project MAI4CAREU. In 2023, "AI Camp 2023" was held on the campus of the University of Cyprus.



Guests of the event were the Rector of the University of Ruse Prof. Plamen Kangalov, PhDEng, the Vice-rectors in Science and Research, Assoc. Prof. Desislava Atanasova, PhD and International Cooperation, Assoc. prof. Galina Ivanova, PhD.

The Rector of the University of Ruse Prof. Plamen Kangalov, PhDEng, greeted the participants with the words "I am happy that the University of Ruse is the host of the International Camp for Artificial Intelligence "AI Camp 2024. During the event, you will share innovative ideas that you have been working on over a period of time, and I am confident that new proposals will emerge and new projects will be developed".



Twenty-two students and mentors from the University of Ruse, Alma Mater Studiorum Universita di Bologna (UNIBO) – Italy and the University of Cyprus took part in "AI Camp 2024". The main goal of the international artificial intelligence camp is to offer students experience gathered from the project network. The added value of the international camp in the field of artificial intelligence is multilayered, as it encompasses transnational cooperation and is associated with the parallel acquisition of knowledge and skills through the study of contemporary topics in artificial intelligence, as well as the opportunity to become familiar with career prospects in industry and research organizations.

The camp involves five teams formed by students from different universities who have been working on projects in the field of artificial intelligence in the months leading up to the event. Each team works with a mentor from the participating universities and presents a scientific report on the chosen topic.



During the winter semester of the academic 2023–2024, the University of Ruse welcomed 62 Erasmus students from 8 countries and during the summer semester – 102 students from 34 universities and 17 countries. A total of 164 international students studied in Ruse for one or two semesters under the Erasmus+ Programme during the academic 2023–2024, which is a record number, compared to previous years.

With Bulgarian folk music, bread and banitsa, Bulgarian students, dressed in traditional costumes, welcomed their new colleagues at the beginning of March 2024. All international students received as Martenitsa and their hosts told them the legend behind this tradition. More than half the Erasmus students – 61, studied at the Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Electronics and Automation, and the rest selected other

Faculties and the Branch of the University of Ruse in Silistra. Twelve of those students studied here for the whole year. It is an interesting fact that Erasmus students from previous years choose to return again – 8 students from Romania, Türkiye and Moldova. The largest group of students coming from a single university is the one from ECE University in Paris, France – 12 students in the winter semester and 20 in the summer semester. The largest group of students from one country is that of Spain – during the winter semester they were 25, coming from 7 universities and during the summer semester, they ware 19 from 6 educational institutions.

During the winter semester of the academic 2024–2025, the University of Ruse welcomed 70 students from 22 universities from 10 countries – Georgia, Italy, Spain, Jordan, Malaysia, Mexico, Romania, Serbia, Türkiye and France. They will study at the University of Ruse for one or two semesters. This is the largest number of students, incoming for the winter semester, the University has ever had under the Erasmus+ Programme.

On 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2024, a welcoming ceremony was held at the University of Ruse for the international students coming under the Erasmus+ Programme. They were traditionally welcomed by Bulgarian students dressed in folk costumes, with ritual bread and salt and a bunch of geranium – a symbol of health.

During the winter semester of the academic 2024–2025, the University of Ruse welcomed several large groups of international students. The largest group is from Spain – 29 students from 10 universities. The largest group coming from a single university is again that from ECE, Paris, France – 13 students. The group from Romani is also quite impressive – 20 students of which 12 come from the National University for Science and Technologies –





the Polytechnics of Bucharest and University Centre, Pitesti and 8 from the Naval Academy "Mircea cel Batran", Constanta, Romania.

The number of students coming for a whole year has grown – they are 19, compared to 12 during the previous academic year. For a third year in a row, students, who have planned to stay for a semester, apply for extending their period after finding excellent conditions of study here.

It is good news that the University of Ruse is expanding its partnerships and welcoming students from five new universities from: Mexico, Italy, Spain, Serbia and Türkiye.

attracts the interest of numerous participants from partner institutions from and outside the European Union, thus strengthening the cooperation and creating long-term friendships. A solid evidence of this is the solid growth of Erasmus mobilities to the University of Ruse.

#### **Work Meetings in the R Moldova**

In the period 11th-13th September, 2024, a number of work meetings were held in the R Moldova for clarifying all questions, related to the accession of Tarakliya State University to the structure of the University of Ruse.

On behalf of the Ministry of Education and Science of R Bulgaria the participants were: Rositsa Koleva Director of Higher Education Directorate, Yana Yotova – Head of Department Implementing the Regulations in the Higher Education Directorate, Milen Botev – Head of Department Funding of Higher Education in the Finance Directorate, Georgi Kirkov – State Expert in State Property and Public Procurement Directorate, Veselina Paunova – Chief Expert in International Cooperation Directorate.

On behalf of the Embassy of R Bulgaria in Moldova there were two participants: Kiril Dimitrov – First Secretary and Martin Vladimirov – Second Secretary. On behalf of the Ministry of Education and Research of R Moldova participated: Svetlana Mironov – Chief specialist in Higher Education Directorate and on behalf of the Tarakliya State University – Assoc. In the period 19<sup>th</sup>–28<sup>th</sup> May, 2024, in Beijing and Ningbo, China the forum China Education Tour 2024 was held with 18 representatives from 9 countries from Central and Eastern Europe. The representative of the University of Ruse was Prof. Theodor Iliev, PhD – Director of Foreign Students Directorate. The main purpose of this event is the expansion and cooperation between the educational institutions of China and the countries from Central and Eastern Europe for the development of higher education, training of talented students and involving business in the educational process. The Agenda included a number of meetings at the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China, the University for Foreign Languages Training, the Beijing Institute of Technologies, Nottingham University in Ningbo, China, the University of Ningbo and others.



On 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2024, Prof. Iliev took part in the Ninth Conference of the Association of Universities from China and Central and Eastern Europe, hosted by the Chinese Association of International Exchange in Education. Nearly 260 Heads and representatives of universities, of government agencies, experts and scientists from China and more than 10 countries from Central and Eastern Europe attended this meeting.

The topic of the Conference was "Quality Education Provides Opportunities for Sustainable Development" and its goal is joint research of new trends and opportunities for cooperation in higher education between China and the countries from Central and Eastern Europe in the light of digitalisation. Prof. Teodor Iliev, PhD represented the University of Ruse in the Panel "Integration between Business and Education". The Conference created three sub-topics: (1) New ways for diversification of student and lecturer mobilities, (2) Digital transformation in support of research and innovations and (3) Integration between business and education and the green development. Leaders and representatives of educational institutions from China, Hungary, Croatia, Bulgaria and other countries shared their experience and practical advancement and proposed plans for supporting educational cooperation between China and the countries from Central and Easter Europe for achieving mutual benefits and winning outcomes.

#### **Erasmus+ Days**

On 16<sup>th</sup> October, 2024, in the central lobby of the University of Ruse an Information Day on the Erasmus+ Programme was held as part of the international initiative #ErasmusDays. Students and PhD students had the chance to meet university representatives, to ask questions about the opportunities for mobilities under the Erasmus+ Programme and to receive some counselling and tips on the application process.

Participants in the Information Day were the Rector of the University of Ruse, Prof. Gencho Popov, PhD, Academician Hristo Beloev DTSc – honorary rector of the University of Ruse and a Chairperson of the Assembly General of the University, the Vice-rector in International Relations, Assoc. prof. Galina Ivanova, PhD, as well as the Vice-rector in Science and Research, Assoc. prof. Desislava Atanasova.

As a long-term beneficiary of the Erasmus+ Programme, the University of Ruse gets involved in the international initiative Erasmus Days, whose purpose is to note the enormous positive impact of the programme in all eligible countries.

The procedure for recruitment of students and PhD students who are interested in Erasmus+ mobilities for training or practice is opened. The University offers possible mobilities with over 300 universities and businesses abroad, providing excellent opportunities for academic and professional development of the students and PhD students in all Faculties and Branches.



### **Eighth Festival of the Chinese Culture**

On 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2024, the Eighth Festival of Chinese Culture was held in Kaneff Centre of the University of Ruse, as a traditional event in the annual programme of the Confucius Classroom at the University. This year's edition of the festival was special and much more solemn because it was on the occasion of the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of diplomatic relations between the People's Republic of China and the Republic of Bulgaria. The Anniversary celebrations started on 29<sup>th</sup> November with the opening of an exhibition and an exciting concert in the central lobby of the University.

The first part of the Eighth Chinese Culture Festival attracted the attention of many visitors with a touch of the wonderful world of Chinese culture - calligraphy, tea ceremony, Beijing Opera masks, fun games and treats. Testimony to the talent of the performers and the high aesthetic value of the concert performances were the non-stop applause of the audience, the warm atmosphere of friendship in the hall to the very end, when the audience joined spontaneously the final dance, carrying the elements of a favourite Bulgarian dance.

Once again, the Festival of Chinese Culture at the University of Ruse turned into an exciting celebration, leaving a mark with the spirit of creative drive that knows no borders and brings cultures together.

Another national competitor was awarded as well - Ognyan Todorov, fourth-year student, Kinesitherapy, in table tennis – a participant in the European University Games with the Bulgarian team. At the National University Games Ognyan won 3 Silver and 1 Bronze Medals.

Students who achieved sporting success in the National University Games 2024 and the National Summer University Sports Games 2024, in the National Championships were awarded.

Student athletes who are champions and medallists from national university competitions and championships were also honored.

The chairperson of the Volleyball section, Senior Assistant Professor Dr. Mladen Petrov, as well as Ivelin Giney, a long-time employee of the university, were honored for their contribution to the development of physical education and academic sports at the University of Ruse during their many years of teaching activity.

### Guinness certificate donation

On 19th March, 2024, Theodor Tsvetkov, a Master degree student in the degree programme Clinical Social Work with the Faculty of Business and Management of the University of Ruse donated his Official Certificate for a World Record, entered in the Guinness Book of Records, to the Ruse Alma Mater.



The renowned swimmer who organised a number of significant charity events and is a champion and medalist from World Championships, conferred the Official Certificate to the Rector of the University, prof. Plamen Kangalov, PhDEng. Theodor wishes to donate his certificates to institutions and sponsors that have supported

him in his endeavours, the University of Ruse being one of them.

"Sports should go hand in hand with studies. We thank Theodor Tsvetkov for his efforts during his studies and wish him to continue studying in the same spirit" – said the Rector of the University prof. Plamen Kangalov, PhDEng, presenting the student the book "Bulgarian Sports Fame" wishing that his records would find a place in its future edition.

"Education is one of the most important values and it really should go hand in hand with sports. I dedicate this record to you because you also have a part in it" – Theodor Tsvetkov said, addressing the members of the Academic Council, adding that his next goal is to swim across the Sea of Marmara.

Theodor Tsvetkov has two records entered in the Guinness Book of Records. One is a one-armed 10-kilometer swim in 4 hours 18 minutes 57 seconds, which was performed in front of a Committee of Guinness Book of Records representatives. He has received the official certificate for that world record as well. So far, only 50 Bulgarians have been entered in the Guinness Book of World Records in various activities, with Ruse student Theodor Tsvetkov being the 51st.

In recent years, Theodor has been competing in marathon swimming distances, which he dedicates to causes related to raising funds for children, youth and adults in need. He is a role model for the younger generation and for all of us. His goal is to inspire people and spread the desire to help.
